**SENIOR CITIZEN RIDE FREE FARE PROGRAM REGISTRATION – 10am-2pm FH**

Staff from the Regional Transportation Authority will be in Frigo Hall from 10am – 2pm conducting registrations for seniors interested in the Regional Transportation Authority's Ride Free Fare Program. This program provides that qualified Senior Citizens (age 65 or older) can ride the CTA (Chicago Transit Authority), Metra or Pace transit systems for free. This registration will be conducted at no cost to you. In order to register as a senior, you must bring **one** of the following documents as a form of identification:

Drivers License, RTA Reduced Fare Permit, Passport, Illinois ID Card, U.S. Immigration Alien Registration Card, Other official Government Identification with a photo and birth date. Your photo will be taken at no cost and affixed to your Senior Ride Free Fare Permit. Upon completion of your registration you will receive your RTA Senior Ride Free Fare Permit through the mail in approximately three weeks.

Nancy from RTA will be in Frigo Hall from 10am-2pm and will begin with a brief presentation at 10am to talk about qualifications, etc. **Please note that she will be here for 4 hours. Plan to spend 3-5 minutes with Nancy. This is a first-come, first-serve event; you may have to wait depending on what time you arrive. You are more than welcome and encouraged to stop in and see if there is a long line that you may not want to wait in; you can always return at another time during the 4 hours she will be here.** The Seniors Ride Free Program has offered free rides for seniors on RTA fixed route services. Recent legislation has restricted the program to those who meet Illinois Department on Aging Circuit Breaker Program guidelines: 65 years and older and a 2010 annual income of \$27,610 or less for 1 person or \$36,635 or less for 2 people. Current Circuit Breaker and Free Ride recipients will receive new cards in the mail late this summer with the pictures that are on file with the RTA from their previous Ride Free card. Seniors who do not meet the eligibility guidelines will receive a reduced fare permit which provides rides at half off the regular price.

Please make an appointment with your Social Worker if you have not enrolled in Circuit Breakers already or to see if you are eligible.
